1. Read minutes of the last meeting – all accepted.
2. Tracy Innes mentioned the possibility of Gary Alexander coming out to Australia for the 2002 seminar (if we provide funds he would come out).
3. Eddie Scharrer / Cameron Owers updated the forum as to the opening of a new branch at Duntroon. At this stage it is a no go, given the cadets other requirements. In the new year Cameron might ask at ADFA.
4. Dave Rowley provided details on the up-coming kids seminar to be held at the Primary School in Batemans Bay on Saturday 14 September 2002. Cost \$12 per person.
5. Dave Rowley informed the forum that Tony McInerny is soon to be presented with his 6th Dan at Tharwa, further details to be provided.
6. Dave Rowley mentioned that Peter Morton is happy to come out to Tuesday night training at Radcliffe to perform fitness tests. This will be at a cost and all funds are to go into the club's central funds.
7. Tracy Innes headed discussions for fundraising activities. It was agreed that each branch was to seek out a donation, all prizes will be packaged together and raffled. The donations are to be brought to the seminar in October and raffle tickets will be distributed for selling. The draw will be held in December and delivered to the winner.

Action Items:

- Tracy has volunteered to arrange printing of tickets and transport of prize if necessary as well as look into getting a permit if necessary.
 - Naomi to compose a letter for distribution to all clubs.
 - Certificate of appreciation to be sent to those businesses who make a donation.
8. D Rowley requested that Greg Fox, Paul Arnold and Marilyn Middaugh become involved on black belt grading panels. Motioned by D Rowley, seconded P Wilson.
 9. **Coaching Accreditation** – D Rowley discussed the need for all trainees to do the same course. D Burgemeister gave reasons as to why he directed Steve to do a boxing coaching course. After

some discussion it was decided that Steve would have to do the Correspondence Level 1 Coaching Accreditation course the other trainees have completed.

Action Item: D Burgemeister and D Rowley to talk to Steve.

10. **Trainee Teaching** – discussion was held with regards to the current teaching contributions being made by both Steve and Dave. It was told that they have been attending St Edmunds with 10 appearances (6 & 4 respectively) between the two of them in the last 13 months.
Action item: D Burgemeister and D Rowley to remind them again of the requirements.
11. **Licensing Agreement** – E Scharrer mentioned that he was keen to get the agreement completed.
12. **Insurance** – P Wilson highlighted the need for all clubs to get their money in to pay for insurance, particularly given the good quote we'd been provided.
13. M Cowey informed the forum that Tharwa branch is to close next week (30 July) as the public hall they currently train in cannot obtain insurance. He will keep all informed of any developments.
14. E Scharrer presented the draft program for the October 2002 seminar, feedback was positive.
15. D Rowley spoke about Allan Waddell asking about the possibility of having a modified junior grading system, for children training aged 4 – 9 years.
Action Item: All present to think about methods to develop one modified system.
16. J Kueter highlighted that the website is currently out of date and needs to be kept current if it is to be of use. Jeroen asked that we talk to SA members about getting it up to date. If no one is SA are able to take it on, south coast region can arrange support.
Action Item: D Rowley to call SA to discuss options.
17. A Maconachie reported on the progress of the book for the 40th anniversary. From all reports it is progressing well and a draft will be out soon for review. T Innes mentioned that Batemans Bay branch will be able to help out with funding for the printing of the booklet.
